

Rules for Selecting the ISU Outstanding Engineer

1. Selection process:
 - a. Nominations will be solicited from the Eastern Idaho engineering community. The Nomination Form is attached.
 - b. Nominations will be reviewed by the Selection Committee. The recipient will be recognized at the annual National Engineers Week banquet.
2. Criteria for selection:
 - a. Sustained exemplary service as an engineer, serving from or within the State of Idaho.
 - b. The recipient should have made a clear contribution to the betterment of the society of Southeastern Idaho through innovative projects and/or community service. This person should be a good example to others both personally and professionally.
 - c. Current and past ISU College of Engineering employees are not eligible.
 - d. The honoree should be able to attend the banquet to receive the award, and must pay his or her own travel expenses.
3. Membership on the selection committee shall consist of:
 - a. Two engineering student leaders: ASISU Student Senator and the current president of the Tau Beta Pi Engineering Honor Society, or their alternates.
 - b. At least two past recipients of the ISU Outstanding Engineer award.
 - c. Two School of Engineering faculty members.
 - d. The College Development Officer
4. Final approval, notification to the winner, and arrangements for the award presentation will be done by the School of Engineering.
